

Lean Six Sigma Master Black Belt Public Training

Brief training overview

Our Public Lean Six Sigma Master Black Belt training consists of 2 x 1 week facilitated training sessions (10 days training) conducted over a 3 month period.

The training is practically based with the training weeks split with a gap of around 6 weeks between each training week. During this period the Master Black Belt candidate will work on skills gaps identified at the outset of week 1 of MBB training and on the projects selected and approved by each MBB candidate's management.

Statistical analysis is carried out using MINITAB™ Statistical Software.

Course Objectives

The aims of the course are to prepare MBB candidates to facilitate effective deployment of Lean Six Sigma and maximise effective linkage of Six Sigma with strategy and any other improvement initiatives, to teach Lean Six Sigma skills within the organisation, coach and mentor Six Sigma projects, select Lean Six Sigma projects and belt candidates, lead and manage large scale Six Sigma projects, analyse final reports for belt certification, and apply more advanced Six Sigma tools. In summary our objective is to prepare Master Black Belt candidates to increase the effectiveness and return on investment of an organisation's Lean Six Sigma deployment.

Entry Requirements

Candidates for Master Black Belt training need to have the ability to work with senior managers to lead major change projects using the Lean Six Sigma skill set, have been a certified practising Black Belt for more than one year and with several completed projects and have good communication skills.

What's included?

Typical course content is shown overleaf.

Courses are non residential and all prices are per delegate and exclude VAT. The price includes tuition, comprehensive training and reference materials. Overnight accommodation is NOT included in the price.

The statistical analysis during the courses is carried out using MINITAB™ Statistical Software. Delegates are required to bring a laptop loaded with Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Word, Microsoft PowerPoint and MINITAB™ to the training.

To ensure maximum effectiveness of training, the numbers of delegates is limited to 10 per course.

Course Content

Outline Training Content

We facilitate the candidates to develop their teaching and presentation skills by first determining their existing capabilities and then preparing & teaching modules to their colleagues, receiving feedback throughout.

We ensure candidates learn how to mentor Six Sigma projects, covering coaching skills, handling conflict, project management, project reporting including company project tracking and individual feedback along with project expectations and deliverables.

We show candidates how to select Lean Six Sigma projects, linking them with company strategy, how to develop the right problem statements, objectives and metrics. Advanced Six Sigma tools are taught to ensure each MBB has the breath of skills to tackle and support more complex and diverse projects. We also deal with selecting projects and Six Sigma Belt candidates, selection criteria and development plans.

Course Booking

Course bookings may **provisionally** be made by contacting Paloma Consulting Limited via telephone, email or fax.

Fees

Upon receipt of a provisional booking, an invoice will be issued. A deposit of at least 20% of the total invoice must be paid within 14 days of the invoice date to reserve a place on the course. The delegate's place on the course is not confirmed until the remaining balance of the invoice has been received and cleared, at least 3 weeks prior to the start of the course.

Please note if the booking is made less than 4 weeks prior to the course then the full amount will be requested in one payment. Invoices will be sent electronically by email unless an alternative method is requested.

The course fee is exclusive of VAT and any other applicable taxes.

The fee covers tuition, course materials and documentation and excludes any overnight accommodation or transportation which will be the responsibility of the delegate.

Payment of the course may be made by Cheque, BACS or Direct Bank Transfer. Full payment details will be provided on the invoice.

By confirming attendance with full payment the delegate is deemed to have read and accepted the terms and conditions detailed here in full, and accepted the cancellation policy detailed below.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations must be made in writing and at least 4 weeks prior to the commencement of the course.

Any cancellations that are made between 4 - 8 weeks prior to the commencement of the course will have a full refund less 10% of the **total** invoice amount.

No refund will be available if the cancellation is made after 4 weeks prior to the commencement of the course.

Paloma Consulting Limited reserves the right to cancel any training session for any reason by notifying delegates of such cancellation prior to the beginning of the training; in which case fees will be fully refunded.

In the event of a cancellation arising from events outside our control, including adverse weather conditions or industrial action, an alternative date will be provided. In such circumstances Paloma Consulting Limited will not offer any refunds.

A Company may substitute a named delegate up to one week prior to the first session of training by giving notice of the substitution in writing. Substitutions **cannot** be made once the training programme has commenced.

Certification

Certification of Master Black Belts is usually specific to each organisation's expectations of their Master Black Belts. Some organisations expect their MBBs to have a strong training and mentoring bias. Others expect their Master Black Belts to have a greater emphasis on leading large strategic projects.

We normally advise aspiring Master Black Belts to deliver a further 2 completed projects with targeted savings, both projects formally written in a report to demonstrate tools and methodology knowledge. They must also demonstrate evidence of training and mentoring an agreed number of Black Belts and their projects to completion, plus any additional skills/requirements determined by the Master Black Belt candidate's organisation.
